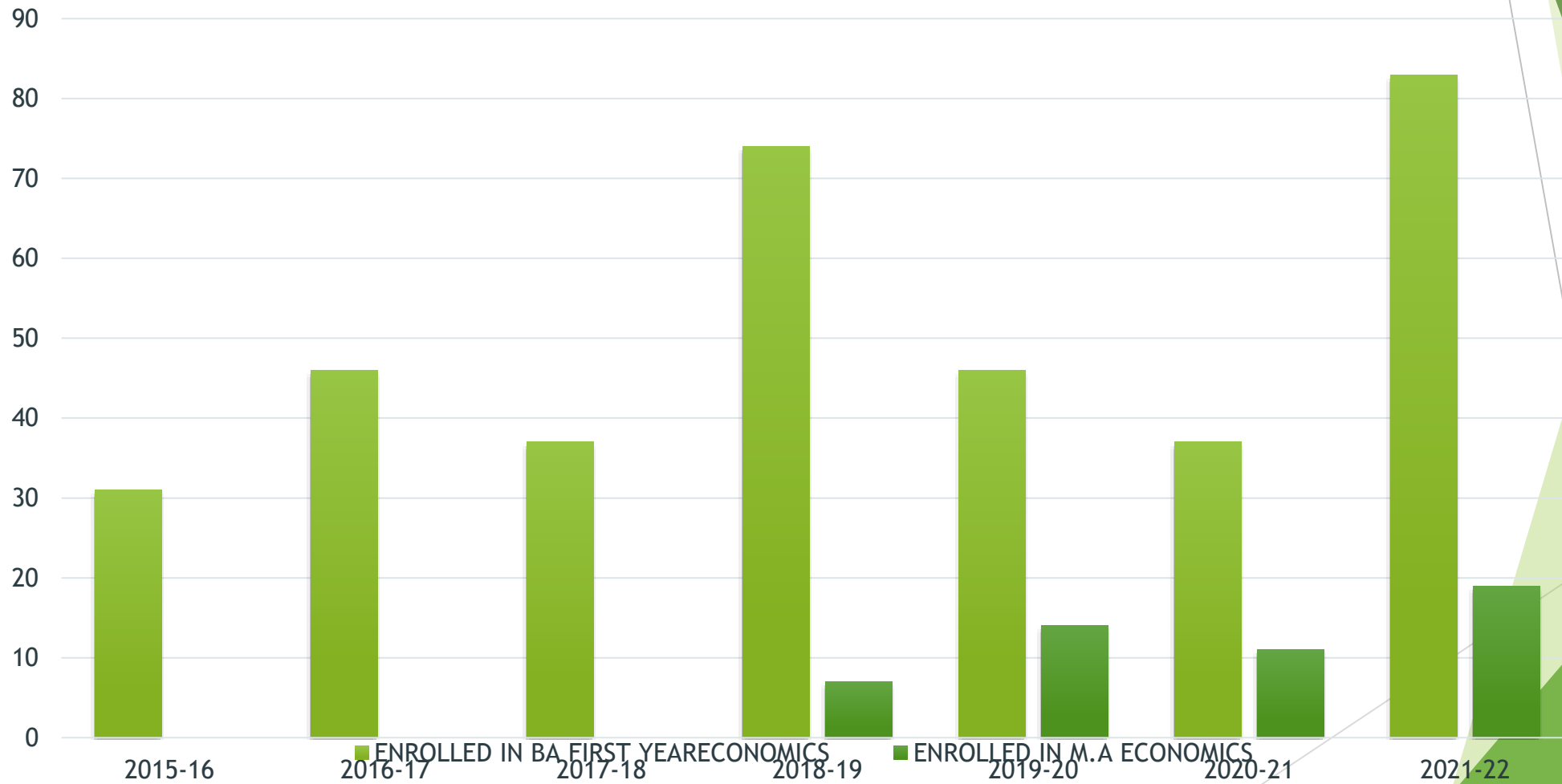
Mission

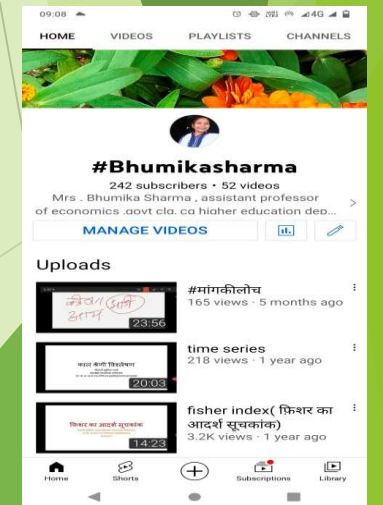

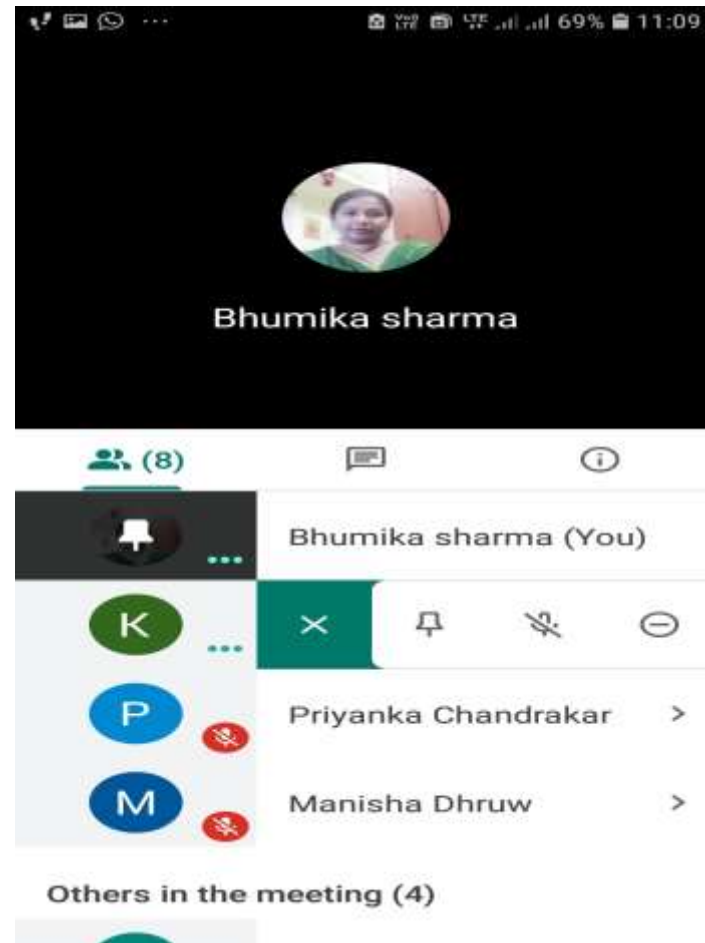

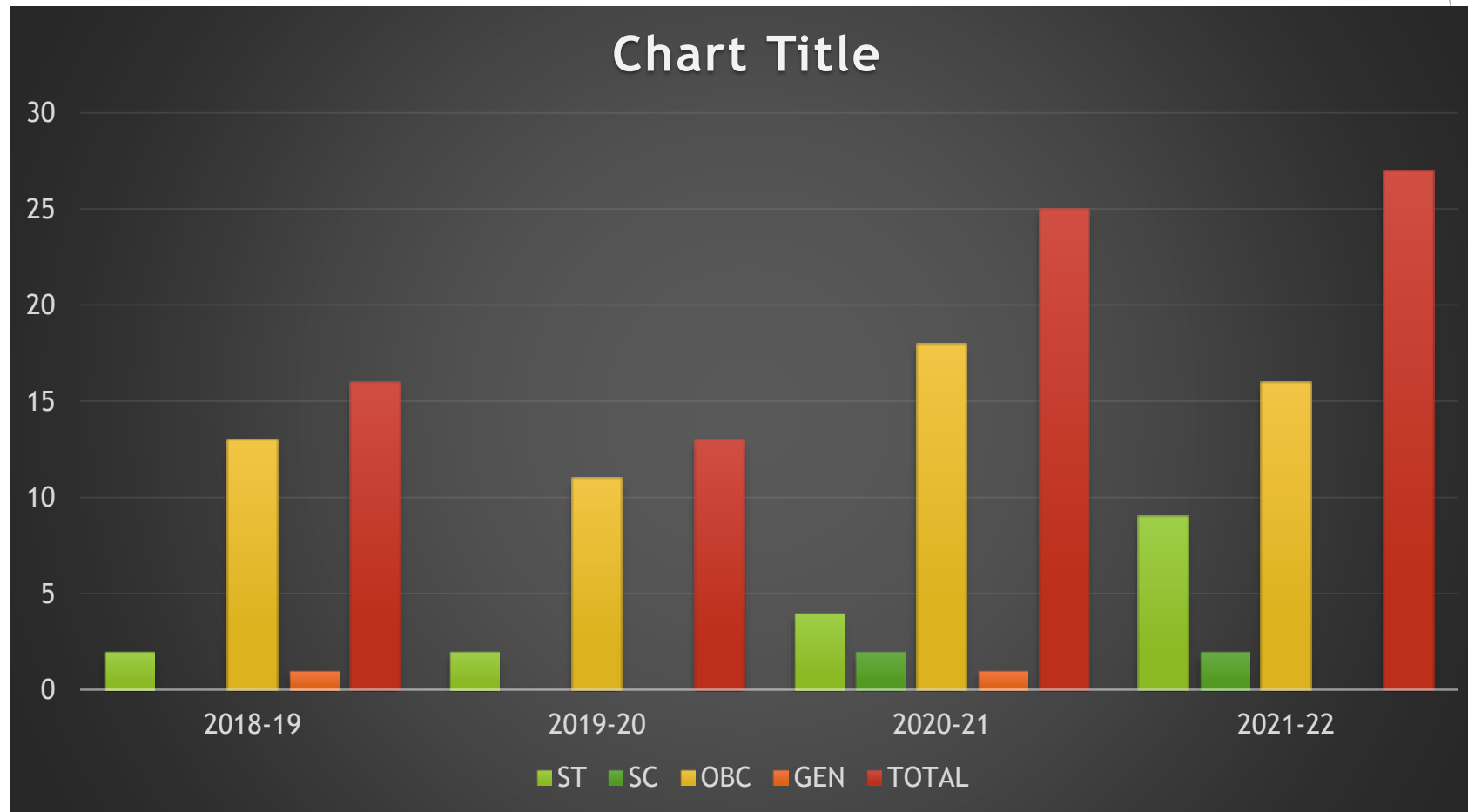


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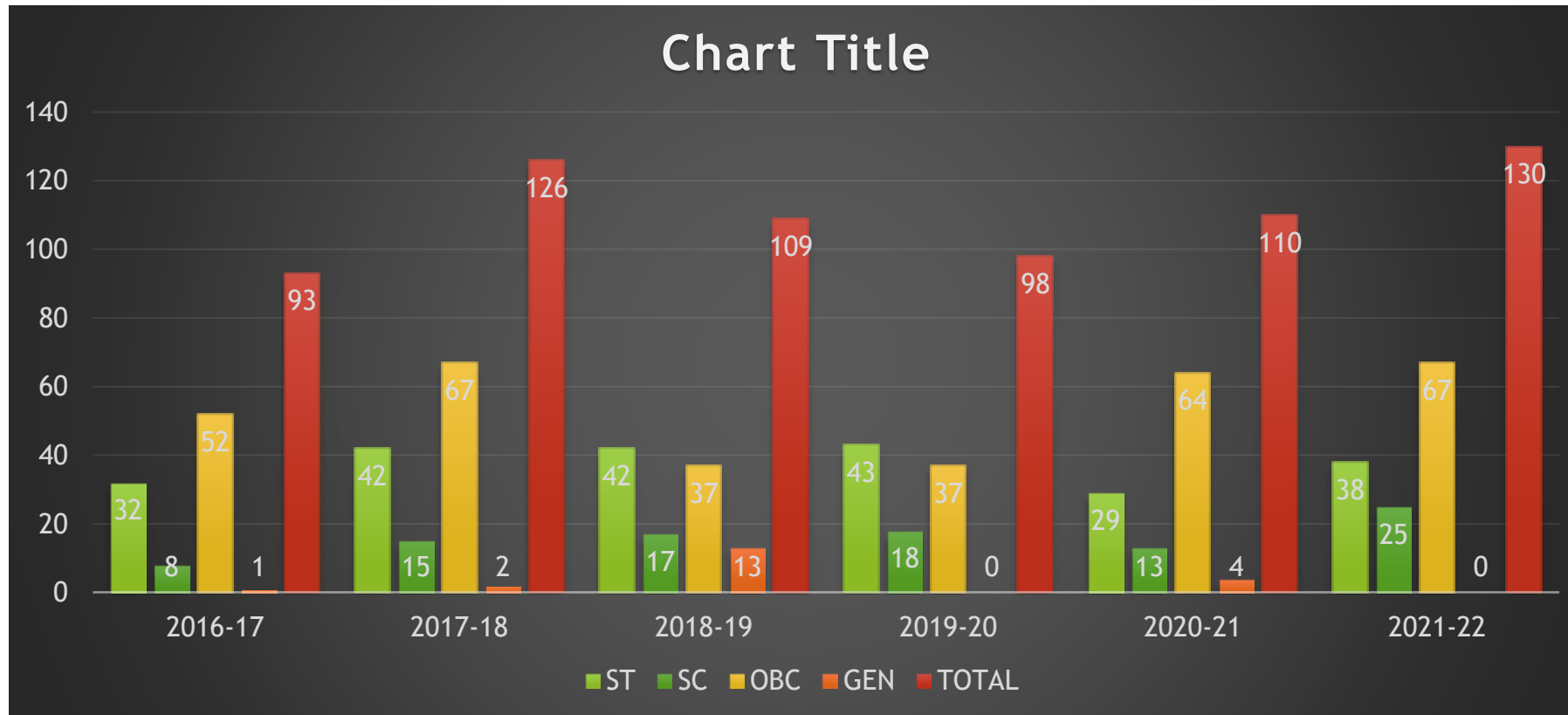

Category-wise Students in PG programme (M. A. Economics, 2018-19 to 2021-2022)



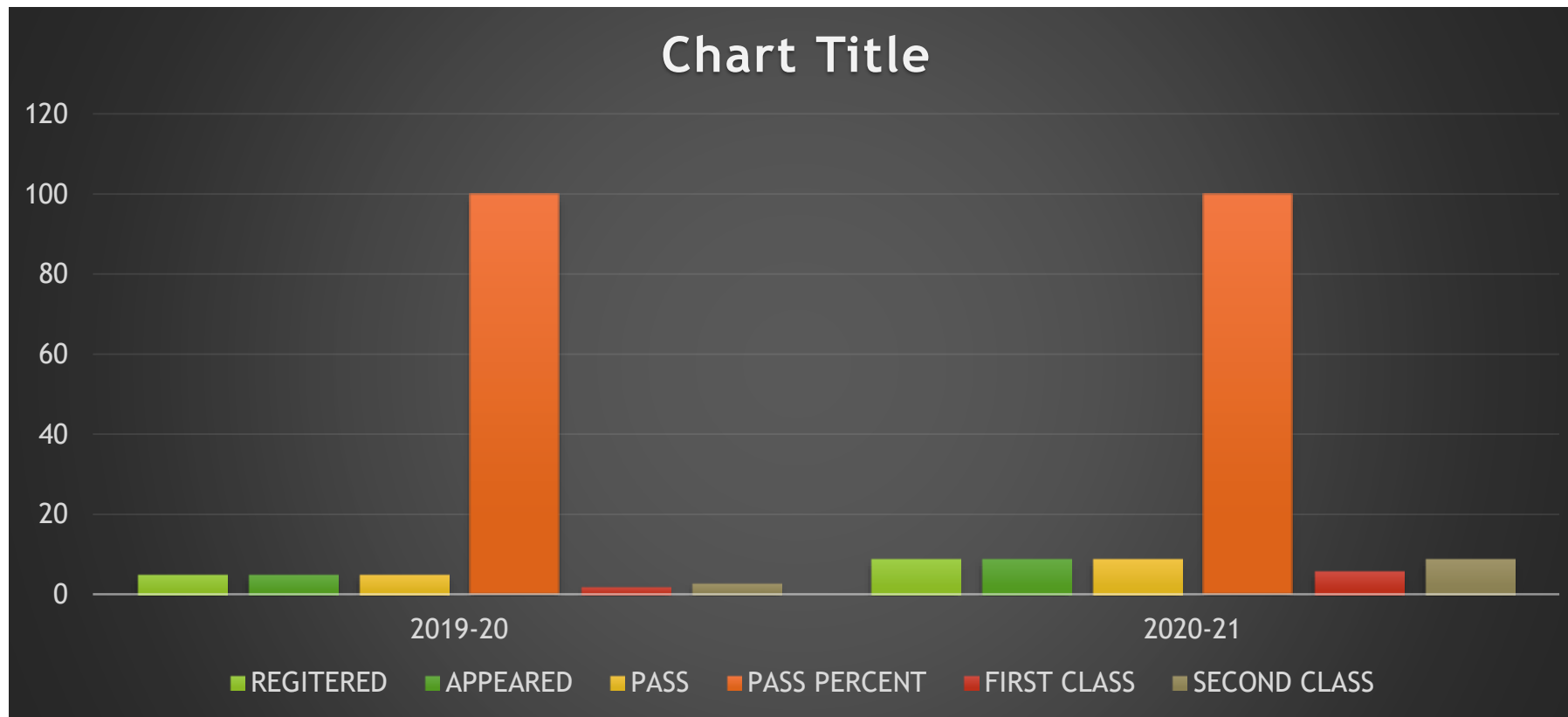
Category-wise students in UG programme (B. A. Economics 2015-16 to 2020-2021)

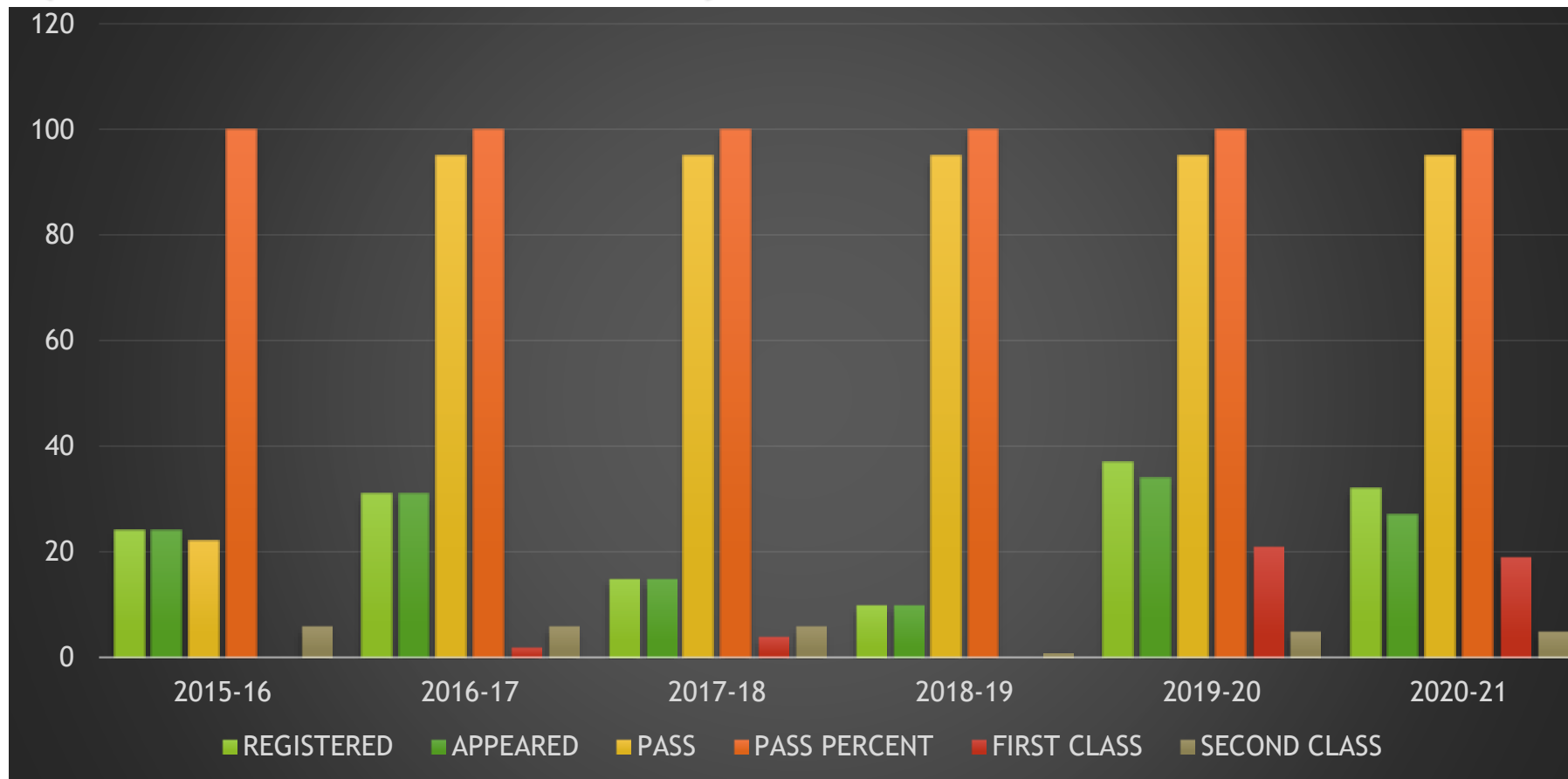
PG Programme (M. A. Economics IV Semester)

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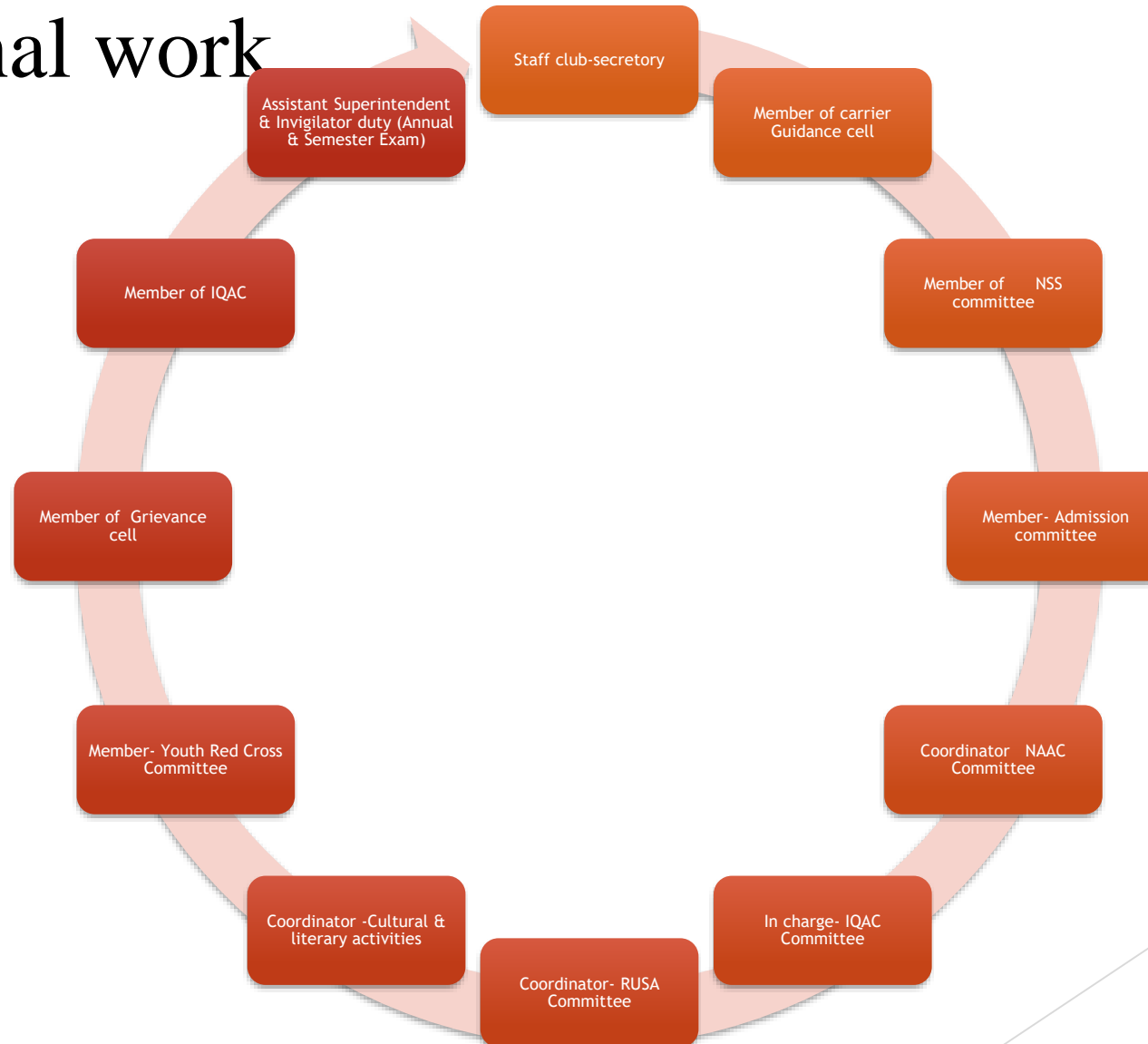

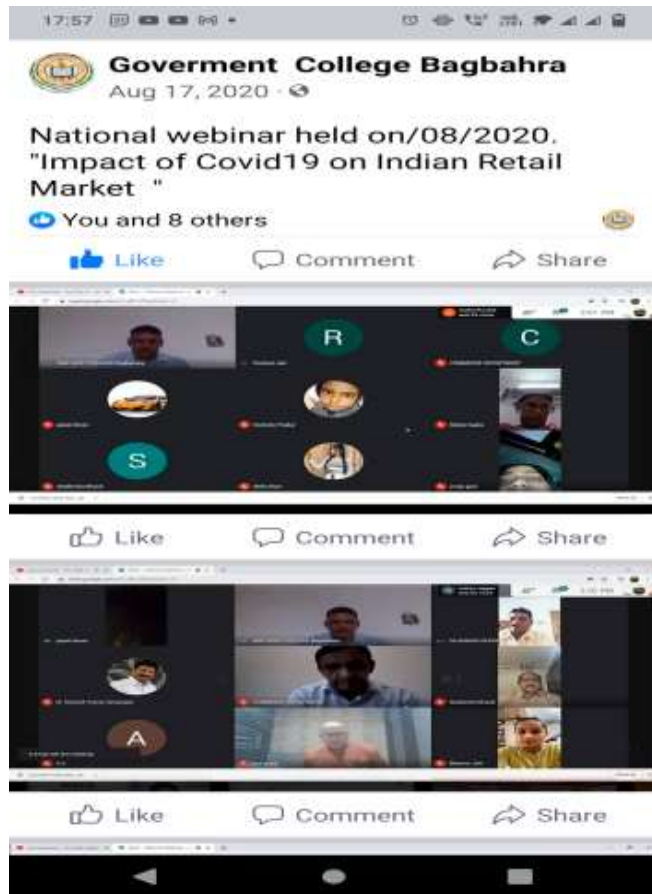
