In this, B.P., blood group, and haemoglobin sickle cell anaemia tests were done. The person who was weak from the point of view of health was sent to the Community Health Center Bagbahara. A total of 55 people were tested in this health test.



Date. On the occasion of National Deworming Day on February 9, 2018, students up to 19 years of age were fed Albendazole tablets. Tuberculosis experts from Community Health Center Bagbahara were present on this occasion. He told them about his treatment and precautions due to tuberculosis. A total of 47 people, including students and staff, were present in this program.



On 4.12.2018, a Workshop on National Mental Health Program and National Tobacco Control was organised in the college in collaboration with District Hospital Mahasamund. A psychiatrist was present. /social worker and a tobacco control counsellor from District Hospital Mahasamund were present in this workshop. He told the students about the side effects of psychotherapy and tobacco. A total of 103 students were present on this occasion.




